Klondike Events (Webelos + Boy Scouts)

- 1. Sled Inspection – (P120)** Gold nuggets are awarded each patrol for the items carried on their sled.
- 2. Iditarod (Sled Race) – (T97)** A patrol musher, a dog sled and a pack of patrol “huskies” race against time.
- 3. Snow Shoe Dash – (T44)** Scouts wearing homemade snow shoes sprint a 6-foot x 20-yard relay. One pair is swapped between patrol members.
- 4. Snow Snake – (T131)** From a running start, Scouts throw a six foot long hand crafted stick from a starting line into a hard packed snow or ice trough. The farthest gliding throw wins.
- 5. 2 Man Log Saw – (T99)** Two patrol members at a time swap off in relay style to remove the end of a log.
- 6. Flint + Steel – (T42)** Patrols build a fire lay and spark the fire which burns through the string that releases the “egg” that falls into the bucket of hot water that is fetched in the ladle that is brought to the judge.
- 7. Hoop + Spear – (P131)** Eight scouts take turns throwing two spears through rolling hoops
- 8. Chilkoat Pass – (T49)** Patrol is timed moving its sled over an uphill and downhill course.
- 9. Hawk Throw – (T80)** Eight Scouts throws two hawks (rubber mallets) to knock down milk jugs.
- 10. Turkey Shoot – (T 7)** Eight Scouts take aim at cast iron frying pans with slings and dried dog food nuggets.
- 11. Cross the Creek – (T126)** Patrols must quickly bring their patrol across a river with ice flows in the shortest time.
- 12. Attack on Fort Russell – (P44)** Patrols must race to scale the walls of Fort Russell hauling themselves, sled and gear over the wall.
- 13. Ravine Rescue – (T100)** Scouts give first aid and rescue “victim” from ravine with rope.
- 14. D. Boone Killed a B’ar – (T132)** Scouts throw a rope over a suspended “limb” 20 feet off the ground. Tie the rope to a 20-pound bear sack. Haul it into the air and tie it off.
- 15. Smoosboard Biathlon – (T97)** Patrol members' right feet are tied to one long 2x6; left feet to another. Patrol is timed in walking a course on flat ground. A challenge is presented along the way.
