Program

Fun and advancement are the most obvious features of the summer camp program. Camp Sequassen is located in Northwest Connecticut at the foot of the Berkshires. Camp Sequassen has one of the most diversified forests found on one tract of land in the state of Connecticut. Meals are prepared by a professional food service in their English Dining Hall. Scouts have the opportunity to take advantage of fully equipped program centers including Aquatics, Scoutcraft, Ecology, Handicrafts, Shooting Sports and Sports. Camp Sequassen has an experienced staff dedicated to providing a superior camp experience for Scouts throughout the Northeast Region.

Information Booklet

The cost for Sequassen 2010 is \$300 per scout, if fully paid by April 2nd, 2010 (the actual cost is \$335 per scout, with Troop 7's fundraising, we're able to contribute \$35 towards the cost for each scout). An information booklet will be available in mid-April that will provide details on medical forms, merit badges, and other pertinent camp information (what to bring, arrival and pick-up times, how to send mail, etc.).

Informational Meeting for Parents and Scouts

Directions

The trip is about 127 miles one way and requires about two and a half hours. Take I-90 West. Take Exit 9 off I-90 and merge on to I-84 West. Take Exit 50 and merge on US-44 West. After about 20 miles, turn left at Town Hill Road. Slight right at West Hill Road. Turn right to stay on West Hill Road. Turn left to stay on West Hill Road. Camp Sequassen is at 791 W Hill Rd, New Hartford, CT 06057.
